- give children, young people and families in disadvantaged areas in Copenhagen better access to art and culture in everyday life.
This is achieved through:
- Volunteers = culture guides who take groups on cultural tours

Why children in primary schools?

- They don't have many lessons with art (music, theater ect.)
- It is very expensive to go to musikschoools, artschoools ect.
- They don't go very often to concerts, theatres ect.
- They are not members of amateur or voluntary art and culture associations

7 June – 12 June 2015

Reform of the primary school in Denmark in August 2014

3 overall objectives:

1. The school should challenge all students so that they get as talented as possible
1. The school must diminish the importance of social background in relation to academic achievement
2. Confidence and wellbeing in primary schools should be strengthened including through respect for professional knowledge and practice.

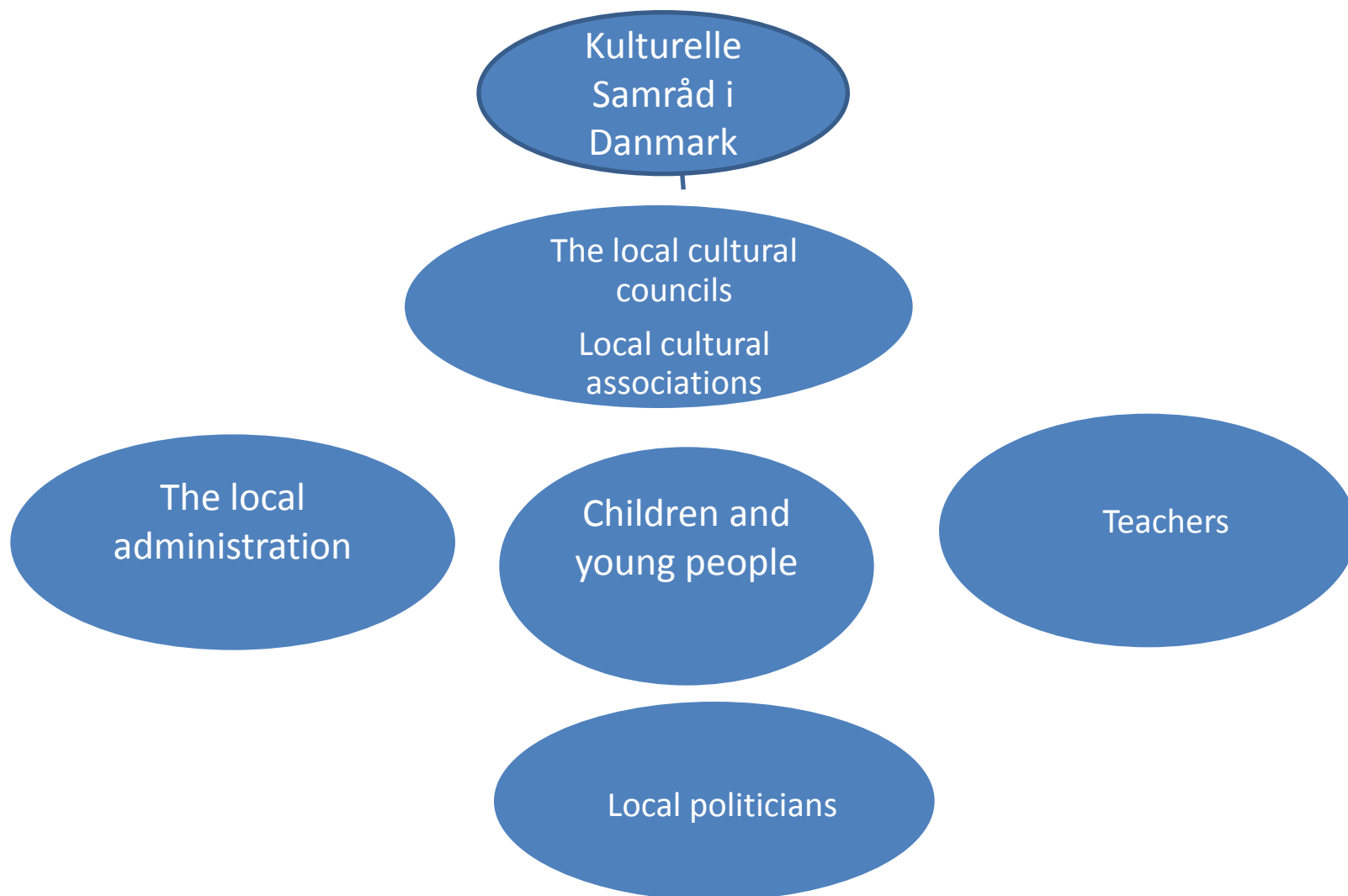
