Culture Guides

 give children, young people and families in disadvantaged areas in Copenhagen better access to art and culture in everyday life. This is achieved through: Volunteers = culture guides who take groups on cultural tours

Steps in the project:

- Define end users (marginalised groups)
- Find project team
- Find volunteers
- Find stakeholders
- Define activities
- Pilot course
- Activities
- Evaluation
- Dissemination
