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Travel information:

Travelling from Liszt Ferenc **airport** to **Hotel Benczúr**, Budapest Benczúr utca 35.

Public transport: Take bus 200E at the airport and take it all the way to the terminal of the bus, change for metro 3, then change for metro 1 at Deák Square in the direction of Mexikói út, and get off at Bajza utca, from there you can walk.

You can buy a ticket from the bus driver for HUF 450, you will need 2 tickets, you can use the same ticket on the two metro lines.

This is the cheapest option.

Airport shuttle bus, which takes you directly to the hotel, costs appr. HUF 4000 one-way, 2nd cheapest for 1 person travelling alone. Book the bus in the arrival lounge.

Taxi costs around HUF 8000-10000, ask the driver beforehand, it's fast and not that expensive for 2-3-4 people sharing the taxi.

By car if you don't have GPS follow the signs to the city centre. Cross the Danube on Chain Bridge and go straight ahead (via József Attila utca, Andrássy út) as far as Kodály körönd, turn right in the roundabout into Felső erdősor utca, then first left into Benczúr utca.

The **City Park** (Városliget) and **Heroes' Square** (Hősök tere) are nearby (walking distance).
