Culture guides - from Nov. 2013 - September 2014 (KSD)

In the Danish project we combine the culture guide project with a school project which is going on all over the country because of a new school law. The new law says that all school children should have contact with their local society i.a. the local associations including the cultural associations - in order to learn more and take more part in the activities – here art and culture, because as it is now most of the children are marginalised when it comes to taking part in art and culture.

We therefore consider almost all children and young people as non- or low-users (and therefore marginalised) as it comes to taking part in art and culture. And as it is difficult to part classes, the whole class form a target group. One could say that small amount of the children and young people from the class who are used to deal with art and culture will function as a kind of culture guides as well.
