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Short description of the organization	Interfolk, Institute for Civil Society is a Danish non-profit and non-governmental association and private research institute, founded in 2008.
	Interfolk is member of the Baltic Sea NGO Network; the International Platform for Citizen Participation (IPCP); the European Network for Active Participation in Cultural Activities (AMATEO); and the European Network for Transfer and Exploitation of EU Project Results (E.N.T.E.R.).
	Our mission is to strengthen lifelong learning activities characterized by personal autonomy, active citizenship, social inclusion and cultural cohesion within liberal adult education, participatory culture, and other civil society associations in a Danish, Nordic and European context.
	The activities of Interfolk include surveys, development projects, courses, seminars, debate, and other cultural activities - in a Danish, Nordic and European context.

Interfolk has the last 10 years with varying roles as partner and coordinator been engaged in:

- 7 Grundtvig and Erasmus development projects, 2 Grundtvig and Erasmus network projects, 4 Erasmus mobility projects, and 1 Creative Europe Network project.
- 7 Nordplus development projects and 2 mapping project, 2 culture point project and 5 Nordic Council of Ministers NGO projects.

What are the experiences of the key person involved in the multilateral cooperation?

The key person involved will be Hans Jørgen Vodsgaard, Head of Institute, Cand. Phil and Mag. Art. (History of ideas and Philosophy). Current member of the Danish coordination committee of the Baltic Sea NGO network, and chairman of the newly founded Danish NGO-network for international project cooperation.



He has been active in liberal adult education and the folk high school movement since the 1980s - as co-initiator and

teacher at Kritisk Oplysningsforbund in Aarhus; Secretary General of the National Adult Education Association, SFOF; as consultant in the Association of Folk High Schools in Denmark; as teacher at Ry Folk High School, as principal of Snoghøj Folk High School and Uldum Folk High School, as project leader for Askov Folk High School, and as research leader for Nordic European Academy.

Bibliography: Furthermore, he has published many books and reports regarding Grundtvigian folk high school tradition, liberal Adult Education, participatory culture, and cultural and arts-based learning and the added community values of culture activities.
