






UP FOR ARTS

Creative mix of radio features on BBC Radio Merseyside profiling learning through voluntary arts/crafts

Helpline support, advice and guidance (run by volunteers) which will refer and direct callers on to local arts/crafts organisations and courses.

Building participation by using BBC Radio Merseyside Performance space to deliver a wide range of interactive arts/crafts taster sessions including exhibitions, events, screenings, and activities.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- Increase participation in voluntary arts/crafts in Merseyside, to improve resilience of communities and raise awareness of the five ways to wellbeing.
- Engage with 12,000 individuals over the course of the year this would be through a range of events, activities, capacity building training session and outreach activities.
- Build an Up for Arts presence on BBC Radio Merseyside.
- Forge a working relationship with BBC Learning and other key departments such as Connect & Engage, Video Nation, BBC Big Screen, BBC Performance Fund and Media City in Salford.
- Link Year of Health & Wellbeing to core VAE activities in train at present, including Once in a Lifetime, Epic Awards and the Voluntary Arts - Art Manifesto programme.
- Take at least 50 calls per week on Year of Health and Wellbeing issues via the 'A' team helpline.
- Cover a wide range of events and activities on both the BBC and Year of Health & Wellbeing websites.
- Establish special one-off event campaigns in partnership with Year of Health and Wellbeing and other parts of the BBC.
- Develop a working partnership with Merseyside Arts & Health Network.
- Establish a range of pilot projects including Arts Timebank and Social Prescribing supported through volunteers and others sources of income.
- Establish an Up for Crafts initiative supported by Heritage Lottery, looking at risk heritage textile crafts e.g. sewing, knitting, weaving, embroidery, mat making, weaving.

UP FOR ARTS: LIVERPOOL

- •In Liverpool there are **354 formally constituted** self organised arts and crafts groups providing learning opportunities
- •43,225 individual members.
- •As a conservative estimate if this project involved just 2% of the Liverpool only, non-participating population through the activities we are proposing it would reach 7,844 participants in 6 months over 12,000


UP FOR ARTS: ADVICE LINE
